Our goal at the Royals Basketball Camp is to bring together young players from all over the area in an environment that will teach them the skills of the game as an individual and stressing the idea of being part of a team. ### Girls Camp Director: Bob Mackey

Bob Mackey has coached in the CHSAA for 26 years, for the last 19 the girl's at Christ the King HS. He has coached teams to 5 National Championships, the last in 2006. Christ the King as been the benchmark for girls basketball for the past 2 decades winning 14 State Championships. Coach Mackey has been the Camp Director at both Five Star and Eastern Invitational. He is the CYO Coach for soccer and basketball at St. Patrick's in Smithtown as well as the parent of a camper. Coach Mackey will oversee all aspects of camp.

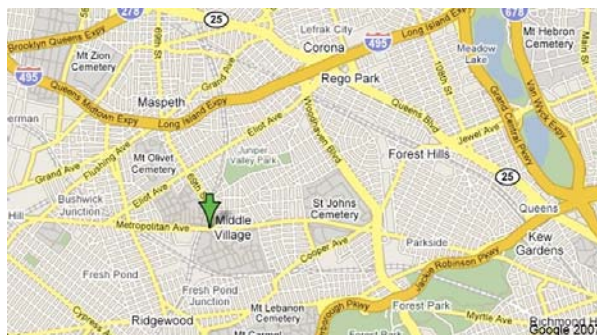
